



Expressions of Interest

Northern Trenches and Dumb River Drainage Ditch Management

The Isle of Man Government invites expressions of interest from suitably experienced contractors to provide Drainage Ditch Maintenance Works on Designated Watercourses to the Department of Infrastructure (Flood Management Division).

The Department of Infrastructure is the Island's flood risk management authority and must generally supervise all matters relating to flood risk management as defined by the Flood Risk Management Act 2013.

The Department of Infrastructure has extensive powers to undertake works in order to manage flood risk. Powers include constructing, maintaining and improving flood risk management assets for example embankments and flood walls and works on designated watercourses to manage conveyance and water levels to make sure flood water can flow freely.

The Department of Infrastructure is looking for a contractor to undertake ditch management works including mowing of ditch banks and in channel weed cutting on the designated watercourses: Andreas Trench, Close Chairn Trench, Close Taggart Trench, Dhoor Trench, Dumb River, Killane Trench, Lhen Trench, and Lough Mallow Trench.

In order to participate in this competitive exercise, your organisation must be registered on the Isle of Man Government's Procurement Portal. Once you have registered your organisation you should select this Quick Quote from the list of 'Current Tenders' and 'View Details' then click 'Express an Interest' at the bottom of the page. Once you have expressed an interest a new tab called 'Quote Documents' will become available where you can download all the necessary information. If you choose to proceed, please select 'Opt In' and a new section will appear for you to upload your completed return documents.
