## **Application for a British Passport**

The power to issue Isle of Man variant British passports is derived from the Royal Prerogative. The Isle of Man Passport Office may issue an Isle of Man variant British Passport to a British national resident in the Isle of Man at the time the application is made; or a person who was born in the Isle of Man and who is resident in the United Kingdom at the time the application is made; or a person with respect to whom His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor considers there are exceptional grounds for him to use discretion in issuing a passport, for example a person born overseas to parents who were Isle of Man born, and were serving in the RAF or Navy at the time the child was born and the child was then brought up in the Isle of Man and went to University in the United Kingdom. British citizens resident in the United Kingdom must apply to HM Passport Office unless they were born on the Isle of Man. Any applicant resident overseas must apply through <a href="https://www.gov.uk/overseas-passports">www.gov.uk/overseas-passports</a>. Please complete this form clearly in **black biro**. Your application may be delayed if you do not enclose; the necessary supporting documents; photographs that do not meet the internationally agreed standards; or the correct fee. - 6) I do not owe any money to the United Kingdom Government for repatriation or similar relief;
- 7) I have stated in section 6 whether the person named in section 2 was born of a surrogacy arrangement;
- 8) I, or the person named in section 2 of this application (if different), am a British national and have not lost or given up my British nationality status;
- 9) I, or the person named in section 2 of this application (if different), am in the Isle of Man or United Kingdom and this application does not break the terms of any court order to which I am subject;
